

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. A-3-15

AN ORDINANCE appropriating monies into certain accounts for the 2015 Budgets of various funds and departments of the City of Fort Wayne, reducing the unappropriated and unobligated balance of the particular fund involved as required to meet obligations for the remainder of 2015.

WHEREAS, the budget adjustment policy of the City of Fort Wayne stipulates that all Departments operating on a tax supported and/or City Council approved budget shall submit requests to the Controller for appropriation of additional monies to the 2015 budgets to provide sufficient operating funds for the remainder of 2015;

WHEREAS, adequate funds exist in the unappropriated and unobligated balance of the funds specified and in the appropriations of certain departments as specified;

WHEREAS, such appropriations have been recommended by the City Controller.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:







# Bill clears Congress

Among the bill's losers are large banks, which would receive lower dividends from the Federal Reserve, with the savings used for transportation programs. Banking officials complained that banks shouldn't be asked to foot the bill for highways and bridges.

The airline and cruise ship industries complained that their passengers are also being asked to pay for improvements unrelated to their travel. The bill ties customs fees to inflation and uses the increased revenue to offset the bill's cost.

It also directs the sale of 66 millions of barrels of oil from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve in order to raise \$6.5 billion. The catch is the sales don't start until 2023 — three years after the transportation bill it helps pay for has expired.

The bill addresses several

concerns raised by a deadly Amtrak derailment in Philadelphia in May. It provides \$200 million to help passenger railroads install positive train control technology that accident investigators say could have prevented the derail-

ment had it been in operation. It also raises the liability cap on total damages that can be awarded in such crashes from \$200 million to \$295 million. The derailment killed eight people and injured nearly 200 others.
