4 **41.07 THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA, CODE OF**
5 **ORDINANCES IN ITS ENTIRETY.**

6 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE**
7 **CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:**

8 **SECTION 1.** That §41.07 of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, Code of
9 Ordinances is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety as follows:

10 § 41.07 COMPREHENSIVE FEE, FINE AND PENALTY SCHEDULE


