

**SECTION 1.** That Chapter 41: CITY FEE SCHEDULES, Section 41.07 Comprehensive fee, fine and penalty schedule, be amended as follows:



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## **CHAPTER 41: CITY FEE SCHEDULES**

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Section

- 41.1 Fire Department may charge for fire reports and photographs
- 41.2 Police Department may charge for police training
- 41.3 Certificate of title inspections; fee
- 41.4 Charge for information from 911 dispatch tapes
- 41.5 Fee for use of Street Department scale
- 41.6 Fire Department may charge for fire, terrorism, rescue, EMS and other emergency related training and services
- 41.7 Comprehensive fee, fine and penalty schedule

### **§ 41.01 FIRE DEPARTMENT MAY CHARGE FOR FIRE REPORTS AND PHOTOGRAPHS.**

(A) Pursuant to IC 5-14-3-8, the City Fire Department shall charge the following fees for fire reports and photographs:

(1) Reports:

(a) First page, \$5.

(b) Each additional page to a maximum of \$20 per each report, \$2.

(2) Photographs, 2 each.

(B) The fees charged by the City Fire Department for reports and photographs shall be deposited in the Fire Fund.

### **§ 41.02 POLICE DEPARTMENT MAY CHARGE FOR POLICE TRAINING.**

(A) The Common Council establishes and fixes the following fee schedule for police training of outside agency personnel:

(1) One-half day instruction, \$20 - \$25.

(2) Full day, \$25 - \$50.

(3) Two day, \$35 - \$75.

(4) Three day, \$45 - \$95.

(5) Week long, \$75 - \$125.

(6) Range rental fee (NRA certified and approved Home Safety Course), \$400 per complete course.

(B) (1) The fees for training outside agency personnel shall be determined by the Director of Training and approved by the Chief of Police;

(2) The fee may be adjusted for special courses and will be based upon the anticipated cost of training that may include instructor fee, room and board, air fare, costs of any duplication services and the like.

(3) Fee waivers shall be permitted at the discretion of the Chief of Police or his/her designee for law enforcement personnel operating within the county.

(C) The fees charged by the City Police Department for police training shall be deposited in the Local Law Enforcement Continuing Education Fund.

#### **§ 41.03 CERTIFICATE OF TITLE INSPECTIONS; FEE.**

(A) *Police officers authorized to inspect vehicles.* Pursuant to IC 9-17-2-12, police officers of the Police Department are authorized to inspect motor vehicles, semi-trailers and recreational vehicles to verify the facts set forth in the application for certificate of title for such vehicles.

(B) *Inspection fee.* The Police Department is hereby authorized to charge a fee in the sum of \$5 for each vehicle inspected. Such fee shall be charged to the owner of such vehicle(s) for the inspection verification of the facts set forth in the application for such certificate of title for such vehicle(s).

(C) *Collection, remittance of fees.* The Police Officer making the inspection is authorized to collect such fees and shall remit such fees daily to the Chief of Police or his duly authorized representative. Pursuant to IC 9-29-4-2(3) the Chief of Police or his duly authorized representative shall remit such fees monthly to the City Controller, who shall deposit such fees in the Local Law Enforcement Continuing Education Fund.

(D) *Receipt for fee.* A receipt for the city title and inspection fee shall be given to the owner paying such fee with a duplicate copy of such form retained by the Police Department.

#### **§ 41.04 CHARGE FOR INFORMATION FROM 911 DISPATCH TAPES.**

Pursuant to IC 5-14-3-8 the City Communications Department shall collect the following fees for the collection, reproduction and dissemination of information from 911 dispatch tapes:

(A) Copy of dispatch tape (1.5 hours prep time/tape), \$25.

(B) Additional time (.5 increments), \$20 per hour.

**§ 41.05 FEE FOR USE OF STREET DEPARTMENT SCALE.**

(A) In accordance with standards set by the state, the City Street Department operates a scale used to weigh trucks and other vehicles.

(B) The fee for use of the Street Department scale is set at \$5 per single weigh-in.

**§ 41.06 FIRE DEPARTMENT MAY CHARGE FOR FIRE, TERRORISM, RESCUE, EMS AND OTHER EMERGENCY RELATED TRAINING AND SERVICES.**

(A) The Common Council establishes the following guidelines to fix fee schedules for Fire, Terrorism, Rescue and Emergency Medical Services related training.

(1) The fees for training outside agency personnel shall be determined by the Director of Training and approved by the Fire Chief.

(2) The fee may be adjusted for special courses and will be based upon the anticipated costs of training that may include, but not limited to: instructor fee, room and board, airfare, costs of duplication services, materials, classroom rental, maintenance and replacement costs and the like.

(3) Fees for services offered to outside agencies shall be determined by the appropriate Division Chief and approved by the Fire Chief in a similar manner as described above for training.

(4) Fee waivers shall be permitted at the discretion of the Fire Chief or his or her designee for other emergency personnel working within the county.

(B) The training fees charged by the City Fire Department shall be deposited in the Fire Education Fund.

(C) The service fees charged by the City Fire Department shall be deposited in the Fire Fund.
