21 Department (the "Department") to ensure the effective operation of the City's  
22 solid waste and recycling collection services through the review and  
23 recommendation of best practices and policies. This purpose shall be  
24 accomplished by:

- 25 (A) reviewing and advising the Department on the need for changes to  
26 collection rates established under this Chapter;
- 27 (B) reviewing the solid waste and recycling collection, sorting and disposal  
28 contracts and advising the Department on said contracts; and
- 29 (C) reviewing and providing input on the annual solid waste budget.
