5 **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF**  
6 **AN APPLICATION TO THE FOREIGN-TRADE**  
7 **ZONES BOARD TO EXPAND FOREIGN-TRADE**  
8 **ZONE NUMBER 182 SERVICE AREA UNDER**  
9 **THE ALTERNATIVE SITE FRAMEWORK**

10 **WHEREAS**, on June 18, 1934 Congress approved an Act “to provide for the  
11 establishment, operation, and maintenance of foreign-trade zones in ports of entry  
12 of the United States to expedite and encourage foreign commerce and for other  
13 purposes” (hereafter the Foreign-Trade Zones Act”); and

14 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with the Foreign-Trade Zones Act and  
15 regulations relating thereto, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana did, on September 18,  
16 1990 apply to the Foreign Trade Zones Board (“Board”) for a GRANT to establish,  
17 operate and maintain Foreign-Trade Zone No. 182 at Fort Wayne, Indiana; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana determined, in accordance with  
19 the Foreign-Trade Zones Act and regulations relating thereto, that it was desirable  
20 to restructure Foreign-Trade Zone No. 182 under the Alternative Site Framework  
21 (“ASF”) as announced by the Board in 74 *Federal Register* 1170 on January 12,  
22 2009. And as such applied and received approval by the Board on June 24, 2011 to  
23 reorganize Foreign-Trade Zone No. 182 under the ASF; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana deems it desirable to make an  
25 Application for Expansion of the ASF Service Area of Foreign-Trade Zone No. 182,  
26 to the Board.

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF**  
28 **THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:**

- 29 1. That the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, Grantee of Foreign-Trade Zone  
30 No. 182, is hereby duly authorized to submit an Application for

1 Expansion of the ASF Service Area of Foreign-Trade Zone No. 182  
2 on behalf of Blackford, Jay, LaGrange, Randolph and Steuben  
3 Counties to the Executive Secretary of the Foreign Trade Zones  
4 Board, Department of Commerce, Washington, D.C. and the Mayor  
5 is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement with any prospective  
6 companies to be in the Zone.

7 2. That any subsequent Administrative Actions, such as the addition of  
8 a Usage Driven application to be filed at the Foreign-Trade Zones  
9 Board relating to this application are also specifically authorized.  
10 This will provide the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana with the ability to  
11 quickly react to a request by a company under the ASF.

12 3. That this Resolution takes effect from and after its date of adoption.
