

4 **A RESOLUTION determining SUBSTANTIAL**
5 **COMPLIANCE OR NON-COMPLIANCE with Statement**
6 **of Benefits (CF-1) form filing for 2019 for Tuthill**
7 **Corporation, Inc. for property at 8825 Aviation Drive**
8 **Fort Wayne, IN 46809 under Confirming Resolution R-**
9 **41-12 with an "Economic Revitalization Area"**
10 **approved under I.C. 6-1.1-12.1**

11 **WHEREAS**, Common Council has previously designated and declared by
12 Declaratory Resolution and Confirming Resolution with approved Statement of Benefits
13 (hereinafter "SB-1") forms, certain property for **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** as an
14 "Economic Revitalization Area" under Sections 153.13-153.24 of the Municipal Code of
15 the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, and I.C. 6-1.1-12.1; and

16 **WHEREAS**, property owners whose SB-1 form was approved after July 1, 1991
17 who file a deduction application under Sections 3 and 4.5 of I.C. 6-1.1-12.1 and Section
18 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, must file a Compliance
19 with Statement of Benefits Form (hereinafter "CF-1") with the City of Fort Wayne and in
20 some cases either the Allen County Auditor, the Allen County Assessor, or both,
21 showing information on the extent to which there has been compliance with the
22 approved SB-1 form for the project; and

23 **WHEREAS**, **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** has filed CF-1 forms with **the City of Fort**
24 **Wayne and the Allen County Assessor**; and

25 **WHEREAS**, **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s** approved SB-1 form stated that **248** full-
26 time and **12** part-time jobs would be retained and **65** full-time jobs would be created by
27 **June 30, 2017**; and

28 **WHEREAS**, **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s** approved SB-1 form stated **\$12,356,400**
29 in annual payroll for the **248** full-time and **12** part-time retained jobs and **\$2,462,000** in
30 annual payroll would be generated by the **65** full-time jobs to be created; and

WHEREAS, **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s 2019** CF-1 form filing stated that **246**
jobs were retained and **zero** jobs were created; and

WHEREAS, **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s 2019** CF-1 form filing stated
\$15,663,200 in annual payroll for the **246** jobs retained and **\$0.00** in annual payroll for
the **zero** jobs created; and

WHEREAS, Common Council designated the City of Fort Wayne Community
Development Division as the entity for the administration, application, processing and

1 monitoring of Economic Revitalization Areas under Section 153.13 of the Municipal
2 Code of the City of Fort Wayne; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Common Council has defined substantial compliance under Section
4 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne as:

- 5 1. Meeting 75% or more of the numbers of full-time and/or part-time jobs stated
6 to be created or retained as delineated in the original Statement of Benefits
7 Form (SB-1) approved by Common Council; and
- 8 2. Meeting 75% or more of the total payroll stated to be created or retained as
9 delineated in the original Statement of Benefits Form (SB-1) approved by
10 Common Council; and

11 **WHEREAS**, meeting 75% of the **248** full-time and **12** part-time jobs retained
12 means retaining **186** full-time and **nine** part-time jobs; and

13 **WHEREAS**, meeting 75% of the **65** full-time jobs to be created means creating
14 **48** full-time jobs; and

15 **WHEREAS**, meeting 75% of the **\$12,356,400** in retained annual payroll means
16 **\$9,267,300** in retained annual payroll; and

17 **WHEREAS**, meeting 75% of the **\$2,462,000** in annual payroll to be created
18 means **\$1,846,500** in created annual payroll; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Common Council may determine not later than forty-five (45) days
20 after receipt of the CF-1 form that **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** has either failed to
21 substantially comply or has substantially complied with the original SB-1 form approved
22 by Common Council; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Common Council made a determination on **June 25, 2019** that
24 **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** was not in substantial compliance as a result of its failure to
25 retain at least **186** jobs with at least **\$9,191,250** in annual payroll and create at least **48**
26 jobs and at least **\$1,846,500** in annual payroll, and that the failure to substantially
27 comply was not caused by factors beyond the control of **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.**; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Council directed the Community Development Division to mail
29 written notice to **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** explaining the reasons for Council's
30 determination and a date, time, place of a hearing to be conducted by Council for the
purpose of further considering **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.**'s compliance with Statement of
Benefits; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned notice was properly prepared and served upon
Tuthill Corporation, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** [**appeared/failed to appear**] before
Common Council to provide additional information concerning compliance.

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE**
2 **CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:**

3 **SECTION 1.** That, Common Council finds that the CF-1 form filed by **Tuthill**
4 **Corporation, Inc.** with an approved Economic Revitalization Area for **2019** are not in
5 substantial compliance pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-12.1 and Section 153.21 of the Municipal
6 Code of the City of Fort Wayne for failure to create 75% of the **65** full-time jobs or **48**
7 jobs that were stated that would be created and create 75% of the **\$2,462,000** in annual
8 payroll or **\$1,846,500** that was stated that would be generated by the created jobs.


9 ~~**SECTION 2a.** **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** failed to appear and otherwise testify~~
10 ~~and therefore Council confirms its determination of **June 25, 2019** that **Tuthill**~~
11 ~~**Corporation, Inc.** has failed to substantially comply pursuant to IC 6-1.1-12.1 and~~
12 ~~Section 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne as detailed in Section 1~~
13 ~~above. Council therefore finds that **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** has failed to substantially~~
14 ~~comply and said failure was not caused by factors outside of **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s**~~
15 ~~control. As a result of said failure, **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s** deduction/abatement~~
16 ~~under **R-41-12** is hereby terminated~~

17 **SECTION 2b.** That **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** appeared and testified at the
18 hearing and from its testimony it was determined that notwithstanding **Tuthill**
19 **Corporation, Inc.'s** failure to substantially comply as detailed in Section 1 above that
20 **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** did make reasonable efforts to substantially comply with the
21 statement of benefits and **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s** failure to substantially comply was
22 caused by factors beyond the control of **Tuthill Corporation, Inc..** Therefore, the
23 continuation of **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s** deduction/abatement under **R-41-12** is
24 hereby approved.

25 ~~**SECTION 2c.** That **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** appeared and testified at the~~
26 ~~hearing and from its testimony it was determined in addition to **Tuthill Corporation,**~~
27 ~~**Inc.'s** failure to substantially comply as detailed in Section 1 above, that **Tuthill**~~
28 ~~**Corporation, Inc.** did not make reasonable efforts to substantially comply with the~~
29 ~~statement of benefits and **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s** failure to substantially comply was~~
30 ~~not caused by factors beyond the control of **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.** As a result of said~~
31 ~~failure, **Tuthill Corporation, Inc.'s** deduction/abatement under **R-41-12** is hereby~~
32 ~~terminated.~~

33 **SECTION 3.** That, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after
34 its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.






