20 waiver of non-compliance of a late-filed CF-1; and

21 **WHEREAS**, CNC Industries, Inc. has filed their CF-1 along with a waiver of non-
22 compliance for failure to file their CF-1 with the City; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the Common Council acknowledges that CNC Industries, Inc. has requested
24 a waiver of non-compliance which the Common Council has the power and authority to approve,
25 under I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-9.5; and

26 **WHEREAS**, CNC Industries, Inc. has fulfilled its pledge to purchase and install new
27 personal property manufacturing equipment; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Based on the CF-1 recently submitted, CNC Industries, Inc. has established
