3, **AN ORDINANCE** approving the initial purchase of a Check Point
4 Security Gateway Orchestrator at a total cost of \$158,454 from
5 Optiv Security Inc and through Allen County, Indiana by the
6 City of Fort Wayne, Indiana,

7, **WHEREAS**, Allen County, City Utilities, and the City of Fort Wayne
8 jointly operate an internal computer network for the purposes of
9 running their respective organizations community;

10, **WHEREAS**, the existing network firewall will reach end of life on
11 December 31, 2021 and the existing firewall cannot be
12 enhanced to support additional work-from-home users;

13, **WHEREAS**, the existing network firewall primarily supports public
14 safety remote communications, as well as work-from-home
15 personnel;

16, **WHEREAS**, Allen County, City Utilities, and the City of Fort Wayne
17 have jointly agreed to share equally in the cost of upgrading the
18 existing network security hardware and software;

19, **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON**
20 **COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:**

21, **SECTION 1.** That the reimbursement of funds for the purchase of
22 Check Point Security Gateway Orchestrator and hardware to Allen County, Indiana
23 for a cost to the City of \$158,454 is hereby approved in all respects.

24, **SECTION 2.** That the City is authorized and directed to take all
25 action necessary for the purchase of this system with Allen County, Indiana.

8, Members of City Council:

9, This ordinance is to authorize the purchase and installation of a Check Point
10, Maestro Solution with two 6500 Turbo Security Gateway Appliances and one
Orchestrator. This system provides several functions:

- 11, • Controls the flow of data into and out of the network. The system has a
12, complex set of rules that govern the flow of data. For example, a common
13, request is to create a firewall rule that allows an internal system to
communicate with an outside system.
- 14, • Allows squad cars and firetrucks to run public safety software at remote
15, locations. The firewall keeps this public safety data separate from routine
data in other departments.
- 16, • Allows work from home users to set up a virtual private network (VPN) to
connect the City/County network and perform their normal duties remotely.

17, In normal times we'd implement the replacement system in late 2021, closer to the
18, system end of life date (the date the manufacturer stops supporting the
19, application). But the social distancing requirements have increased the system
20, load and we are preparing for that load to increase further. Allen County will be the
lead purchaser for the system. Allen County will bill City Utilities \$79,227 in 2020
and bill Civil City \$79,227 in 2021.

21, This system is critical to daily work of sworn officers in police and fire that access
22, the network remotely. Other city inspectors use the VPN as part of their daily
23, functions.

24, For the duration of the virus mitigation the system will be crucial to the City and
25, County personnel working from home. Moving on this upgrade early will help our
remote workers proceed in as normal a manner as possible.
