

A RESOLUTION approving Compliance with Statement of Benefits (CF-1) form filings for 2022 for properties with approved “Economic Revitalization Areas” under I.C. 6-1.1-12.1

WHEREAS, Common Council has previously designated and declared by Declaratory Resolution and Confirming Resolution with approved Statement of Benefits (SB-1) forms property for the following property owners as “Economic Revitalization Areas” under Sections 153.13-153.24 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, and I.C. 6-1.1-12.1, to wit:

Attached hereto as “Exhibit 1” as if a part herein; and

WHEREAS, property owners whose Statement of Benefits (SB-1) form was approved after July 1, 1991 who file a deduction application under Sections 3 and 4.5 of I.C. 6-1.1-12.1 and Section 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, must file a Compliance with Statement of Benefits Form (CF-1) with the Allen County Auditor, the Allen County Assessor and the City of Fort Wayne showing information on the extent to which there has been compliance with the approved Statement of Benefits for the project; and

WHEREAS, property owners in Exhibit 1 have filed Compliance with Statement of Benefit Forms with the Allen County Auditor’s Office, Allen County Assessor’s Office and the City of Fort Wayne; and

WHEREAS, Common Council designated the City of Fort Wayne Community Development Division as the entity for the administration, application, processing and monitoring of Economic Revitalization Areas under Section 153.13 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne; and

WHEREAS, Common Council has defined substantial compliance under Section 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne as:

1. Meeting 75% or more of the numbers of full-time and/or part-time jobs stated to be created or retained as delineated in the original Statement of Benefits Form (SB-1) approved by Common Council; and
2. Meeting 75% or more of the total payroll stated to be created or retained as delineated in the original Statement of Benefits Form (SB-1) approved by Common Council; and

WHEREAS, each of the entities listed in Exhibit 1, by and through the evidence provided in their respective CF-1 forms have failed to substantially comply with their originally filed and approved SB-1 forms within the parameters of the definition of substantial compliance; and

WHEREAS, Common Council shall determine not later than forty-five (45) days after receipt of the Compliance of Statement of Benefits Form (CF-1) that the property owner has

1 substantially complied with the original Statement of Benefits Form (SB-1) approved by Common
2 Council.

3 **WHEREAS**, on March 6, 2020 the State and Governor of Indiana issued Executive Order
4 20-02 Declaration of a Public Health Emergency for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Executive Order 20-02 was extended multiple times through the remainder of
6 2020 and into early 2021, these executive orders and related restrictions and responses to the
7 Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak affected the economy on a State, County and City level; and

8 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to IC 6-1.1-12.1 and Section of 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the
9 City of Fort Wayne consideration is given in determining substantial compliance to businesses who
10 face outside forces beyond their control in making reasonable efforts to substantially comply with
11 their approved statement of benefits; and

12 **WHEREAS**, all of the property owners listed in Exhibit 1 faced outside forces beyond their
13 control during the Public Health Emergency for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak as declared
14 and extended multiple times under Executive Order 20-02; and


15 **WHEREAS**, lingering effects of the Public Health Emergency for Coronavirus Disease
16 2019 Outbreak have continued to impact the economy on a State, County and City level in through
17 early 2022 making hiring and retaining employees difficult; and

18 **WHEREAS**, all of the property owners listed in Exhibit 1 filed their 2022 compliance
19 documents in a timely manner and have provided information indicating they made efforts to be in
20 substantial compliance; and

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY
22 OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:**

23 **SECTION 1.** That, the Compliance with Statement of Benefits Forms (CF-1) filed for
24 property owners listed in Exhibit 1 with approved economic revitalization areas are in substantial
25 compliance pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-12.1 and Section 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the City of
26 Fort Wayne.

27 **SECTION 2.** That, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its
28 passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
