

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING PROJECTS AND FUNDING INCLUDED
IN THE FORT WAYNE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA)
APPROVED PLAN**

WHEREAS, the U.S. Congress enacted the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021("ARPA") in March 2021; and

WHEREAS, ARPA provides emergency funding to state and local governments to support their recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana has been allocated \$50,815,327.00 from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (under "ARPA"); and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne adopted Special Ordinance on S-58-21 on May 11, 2021, which established the purpose, permitted uses and minimum percentages per category of the ARPA fund; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne adopted Resolution R-22-03-22 on April 12, 2022 approving the City of Fort Wayne Recovery Plan, State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne must obligate its ARPA funds by the end of 2024 and ultimately spend the funds by the end of 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne desires the Common Council to approve the projects and funding requested from the ARPA funds as per the approved plan:

Packard Park	\$1,800,000
Franke Park Ph 1	\$5,000,000
Southeast Grocery Store	\$2,000,000
SE District Streetscape (Pontiac St)	\$1,700,000

SECTION 1. The Common Council approves the above projects and the funding


