

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FORT WAYNE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND (SLFRF) SMALL BUSINESS SUPPORT GRANT OPPORTUNITY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE.

Whereas, the U.S. Congress enacted the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (“ARPA”) on March 11, 2021; and,

Whereas, ARPA provides emergency funding to state and local governments to support their recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

Whereas, the City of Fort Wayne has been allocated \$50,815,327.00 from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (under “ARPA”) which must be obligated by the end of 2024 and expended by the end of 2026; and,

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana adopted Special Ordinance S-58-21 on May 11, 2021 which established the purpose, permitted uses and minimum percentages per category of the ARPA fund; and,

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana adopted Resolution R-22-03-22 on April 12, 2022 approving the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana Recovery Plan, State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and,

Whereas, City leaders have been deliberate and thoughtful on this process in order to adhere to federal rules and eligibility criteria while providing both an opportunity for community input and an opportunity to meet the most urgent and significant needs in Fort Wayne using areas of focus; and,

Whereas, the City of Fort Wayne desires to support organizations working to serve the community in the tourism, public health, small business, and non-profit sectors by implementing four separate subgrant programs utilizing ARPA funds subject to local, state, and federal regulations; and,

Whereas, the City of Fort Wayne is working diligently, using federal and state

1 guidance and industry best practices, to ensure applicable programmatic, financial, and
2 administrative eligibility and compliance for subgrant recipients; and,

3 **Whereas**, the City of Fort Wayne is also working to ensure the subgrants are
4 targeted towards industries, organizations, and community members most seriously
5 impacted or disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

6 **Whereas**, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana adopted
7 Resolution R-22-06-09 on June 28, 2022 approving the four subgrant programs,
8 including Small Business Support with the goal of mitigating the negative economic
9 effects of COVID-19, and;

10 **Whereas**, after extensive reviews, the City of Fort Wayne desires the Common
11 Council to approve the grant awards in the subgrant program of Small Business Support
12 not to exceed the amounts in the attached summary after each awarded applicant has
13 successfully undergone a federally-required risk analysis and any other applicable legal
14 requirements,


15 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE**
16 **CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:**

17 **SECTION 1.** The Common Council approves the attached grant awards in the
18 Small Business Support program not to exceed their respective funding amounts from
19 the ARPA funds.

20 **SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its
21 passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
