The contractor shall furnish all labor, insurance, equipment, materials and power for the completion of the project: 2011 CIPP Package #1 Medium Diameter as follows: Rehabilitation of approximately 7,059 LF of medium diameter (18-inch to 36-inch) sanitary and combined sewer by means of a cured-in-place pipe method.

Implications of not being approved: Pipe segments being lined are in a deteriorated condition and have a great potential for pipe collapse and failure. Groundwater infiltration is also a concern in these areas. Not completing this project will add to the amount of water getting into our sewer system that then has to be treated at the Water Pollution Control Plant. Also, if a pipe section should collapse, a point repair would be required driving up the maintenance costs for the sewer utility.

If Prior Approval is being Requested, Justify: N/A

This project was advertised to contractors on March 25, 2011, April 1, 2011 in the Journal Gazette; March 25, 2011, April 1, 2011 in the News Sentinel and March 30, 2011 in Frost Illustrated.

The contract for Resolution # 2391-2011 awarded to Reynolds Inliner LLC for \$455,341.00 was the lowest most responsive bidder of 2 bidders and 8% below the Engineer's estimate of \$489,790.00. The second lowest bidder was \$24,811.50 above Reynolds Inliner LLC's bid.
