SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. S- 3-13

AN ORDINANCE of the Common Council approving and ratifying the extending of the Collective Bargaining Agreement including all Memoranda Agreements and Letters of Agreement through December 31, 2013; and fixing, establishing and ratifying compensation for the year 2013 for Police Officers Represented by The Fort Wayne Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc.

WHEREAS, the Collective Bargaining Agreement for The Fort Wayne Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc. has been previously approved by the Common Council, Ordinance S-213-11; and

WHEREAS, the City and The Fort Wayne Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc. have agreed to extend the current Collective Bargaining Agreement, including all existing Memoranda Agreements and Letters of Agreement through December 31, 2013; and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana law, the compensation provided for therein must be annually ratified; and

WHEREAS, the base pay for the Police Officers represented by The Fort Wayne Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc. will be increased by 2% for the year 2013; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The extension of the Collective Bargaining Agreement for The Fort Wayne Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc. including all Memoranda Agreements and Letters of Agreement is hereby approved and ratified through December 31, 2013.

SECTION 2. The compensation for Police Officers represented by The Fort Wayne Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc. is hereby ratified and approved for the year 2013.




The City of Fort Wayne ("City") and the Fort Wayne Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc. ("PBA") agree as follows:


1. The City will increase base pay for PBA members by 2% for 2013.






