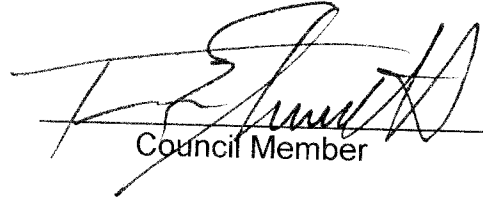

**Description and Scope of Work:**

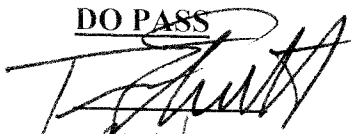

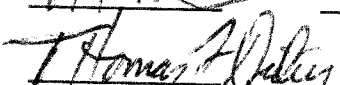
