SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. S-62-15

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RIVERFRONT DEVELOPMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, in December 2012, the City through its Community Legacy Fund process approved funding for a Riverfront Action Plan that would provide the road map to implement a world class downtown riverfront development; and,

WHEREAS, in early 2014, the Riverfront Action Plan was completed and presented to the community; and,

WHEREAS, the Riverfront Action Plan presents a revitalized downtown riverfront that will involve substantial community and stakeholder participation and input in each phase of the development; and,

WHEREAS, the Community Foundation of Greater Fort Wayne has committed to provide \$3,000,000 toward the riverfront implementation effort; and,

WHEREAS, the Fort Wayne Capital Improvement Board of Managers (CIB) has approved a maximum pledge of \$3,000,000; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne City Council has approved a distribution of \$6,000,000 from the Community Legacy Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Controller believe the multiple sources of funding should be retained in a separate fund to ensure clear accountability of the funding streams for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:


SECTION 1. The Riverfront Development Fund shall be established for the purpose of holding, accounting for, administering and appropriating all funds for this specific project.
