12 reporting software will be mandatory for all public law
enforcement agencies across the nation;

Subject: Purchase of the Spillman NIBRS (National Incident-Based Reporting System)

Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of the Spillman NIBRS (National Incident-Based Reporting System) module, the Spillman Learning Management System, and software maintenance for these systems.

Through the work of Officer Scott Kizziar, Officer Rick Wurm, and the Director of Public Safety grant Deb Morrone, the city has received a received a grant of \$120,335 from NCS-X, the National Crime Statistics Exchange. In two years the use of standard crime reporting software will be mandatory for all public law enforcement agencies across the nation. Since Fort Wayne agreed to be a pilot city for this software, we were awarded this federal grant to purchase the software.

This grant will cover the cost of the modules and two years of annual maintenance for the modules. In subsequent years the additional annual maintenance cost is \$11,835.

The software modules will become part of the larger Spillman public safety computer system, and be available to all the local public safety units that share it.
