10 outlined in Section 603(c) are as follows:

- 11 - To respond to the pandemic or its negative economic impacts, including  
12 assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid to impacted  
13 industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality;
- 14 - For premium pay to eligible workers performing essential work (as determined  
15 by each recipient government) during the pandemic, providing up to \$13 per  
16 hour above regular wages;
- 17 - For the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in  
18 revenue due to the pandemic (relative to revenues collected in the most recent  
19 full fiscal year prior to the emergency);
- 20 - To make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure;
