2 SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. S- 114-21
3 AN ORDINANCE fixing the salaries of
4 each and every appointed officer,
5 employee, deputy assistant, departmental
6 and institutional head of the Civil
7 City and City Utilities of the City
8 of Fort Wayne, Indiana for the year 2022

9 WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Fort
10 Wayne, Indiana, have according to the powers outlined in IC 36-4-7-3 assigned to
11 each employee of the Civil City of Fort Wayne and of City Utilities of Fort Wayne a
12 job classification under the City Classification System, which job classification
13 should accurately reflect the duties and responsibilities of said employees, and

14 WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Fort Wayne has recommended
15 a maximum salary level for each job classification should accurately reflect the
16 duties and responsibilities of said employees, and

17 WHEREAS, the Clerk of the City of Fort Wayne, the Board of Park
18 Commissioners, and the Metropolitan Human Relations Commission have
19 recommended job classification designations for positions within their respective
20 jurisdictions, and

21 WHEREAS, the Common Council must assure that salaries reflect
22 the duties and responsibilities assigned to each employee, and to be certain that
23 such salaries are fair and equitable and

24 WHEREAS, the funds of such salaries are to be provided for the
25 2022 City Budget and from City Utilities operating funds and other
26 sources as may be specified by Common Council.

27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON
28 COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

29 SECTION 1. That all employees of the Civil City of Fort
30 Wayne and of City Utilities, shall be classified by the division/department, job
classification, and titles.

SECTION 2. That the following Grid is hereby fixed and
authorized as a scale for approved job classifications. Consistent with our
compensation philosophy, it is the City's policy that no employee shall be paid below
the minimum and the maximum should not be exceeded, except for approved
special occupations, shift differentials, approved longevity pay, approved overtime

1 pay, approved technical skill pay, approved clothing allowance, approved previously
 2 accrued vacation payoff, sick time, FLSA earned compensatory time, approved car
 3 allowance or approved productivity bonus, as outlined in the City's approved work
 4 rules.

7 This Grid, as reflected on Exhibit "A", is an attempt to maintain an orderly, consistent
 8 and competitive pay policy that includes a "bonus" program for superior
 9 performance and a "Grid System" that represents the actual market range for
 10 positions within the City of Fort Wayne and City Utilities.

11 **SECTION 3.** The following job classifications are a true and complete listing
 12 of all Civil City and City Utilities positions by division/department, job classification,
 13 and titles.

SECTION. 4. Pursuant to State Statute economic conditions must be approved by the Common Council. Such economic conditions include, but are not limited to, base pay and monetary fringe benefits, as outlined in the City's approved work rules.

SECTION 5. In addition to the compensation for positions listed herein the City shall contribute 3% of employees' salary to the Indiana Public Retirement System (INPRS).

SECTION 6. That, in addition to the compensation provided for herein: The City of Fort Wayne Law Department shall receive not more than \$6,500 for services performed in connection with the operations of the municipally owned utilities pursuant to I.C. 36-4-74 which additional compensation shall be paid from the revenues of the appropriate utility or function. The City of Fort Wayne Law Department shall also receive an additional sum not to exceed \$13,000 for services provided in connection with the City Self-Insurance Program involving matters not in litigation.

Any and all payments to be made hereunder for extraordinary services shall be subject to the final approval by the City Controller. Nothing in this agreement shall prevent the use of other attorneys or firms to perform extraordinary services, subject, however, to the provisions of IC 36-4-9-12.

SECTION 7. From and after the first day of January, 2022 all appointed officers, employees, deputies, assistants, Departmental, and institutional heads of the Civil City and City Utilities will be paid according to this, the above and following provisions of this ordinance, subject to budgetary limitations, future changes or amendments enacted by Common Council.

SECTION 8. That all Departments subject to this Ordinance will conform to the Official City's Personnel Policies and Procedures relating to hiring, pay, and other related practices, approved by the Mayor and

1 administered by the City's Human Resources Department.

2 **SECTION 9.** If any section, clause, sentence, paragraph
3 or part or provisions of this Ordinance be found invalid or void by a Court of
4 competent jurisdiction, it shall be conclusively presumed that this ordinance would
5 have passed by the Common Council without such invalid section, clauses,
6 paragraph, part or provisions, and the remaining parts of the Ordinance will remain
7 in effect.

8 **SECTION 10.** The Municipal Code of the City of Fort
9 Wayne references, in codification form, salary ordinances previously adopted by the
10 City Council for past years. Such salary ordinances have a duration of one year and
11 thus, with the exception of the 2021 salary ordinances, have expired.
12 Commencing January 1, 2022, any conflict between the terms and
13 conditions hereof and any previous ordinance shall be resolved in favor of the most
14 recently enacted ordinance.

15 **SECTION 11.** Two copies of all attachments and Exhibits
16 referred to in this Ordinance shall be kept on file with the City Clerk of Fort Wayne
17 for the purpose of public inspection.

18 **SECTION 12.** This ordinance shall be in full force and
19 effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
