14 involving a total cost not to exceed TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND AND
15 00/100 DOLLARS - (\$250,000.00) – (total costs are anticipated to go over
16 \$100,000) all as more particularly set forth in said INCREASE FOR PURCHASE
17 OF LIGHTING MATERIALS which is on file in the Office of the Department of
18 Purchasing, and is by reference incorporated herein, made a part hereof, and is
19 hereby in all things ratified, confirmed and approved.

Subject: Street Light Material Increase in Purchase Order Amount

Division of Public Works, Street Light Engineering/Operations Division is seeking approval for an increase for our Purchase Order amount with ESL Spectrum, Inc. not to exceed \$250,000 for 2022.

This increase is being requested for the following reasons:

- 1) Public Works would like to establish a PO with ESL Spectrum to purchase lighting products for various projects in the city.
- 2) Since products are from a sole source vendor, Public Works is requesting no bids are needed.
- 3) ESL Spectrum has provided to Public Works Sole Source provider letters from 5 different lighting product vendors used by Street Light Operations.
- 4) Street Light Operations will be doing project, maintenance, and replacement work with these products, and anticipates that costs will go over \$100,000.

The City has standardized our lighting products to help control our inventory and keep lighting compatible with existing and new fixtures. Some of the products provided by ESL Spectrum are also proprietary to Fort Wayne, such as our Downtown Light Poles.

The increase in the PO will also allow for more in-house work to be done by avoiding having to contract out work.
