7 **WHEREAS**, public safety software is integral to the  
8 operation of police, fire, and 911 services:

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON**  
10 **COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:**

11 **SECTION 1.** That the yearly maintenance of Spillman Flex Public  
12 Safety software from Motorola Solutions for a total of cost to the City of \$336,665 is  
13 hereby approved in all respects. That said yearly maintenance will be used to  
14 ensure the proper operation of the City's police, fire and 911 systems.

15 **SECTION 2.** That the City is authorized and directed to take all action  
16 necessary for the purchase of this system by and through Motorola Solutions.

17 **SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from  
18 and after its passage and all necessary approval by the Mayor.

Subject: Yearly Maintenance for Spillman Mobile software

Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of yearly maintenance for Spillman Flex Public Safety software from Motorola Solutions for the operation of the City's police, fire and 911 departments. This year's maintenance cost is \$336,665.

This payment is made annually and represents approximately one half of the Spillman maintenance cost. Allen County pays the other half of the maintenance.

In exchange for maintenance fees, the software vendors provide support for problems with the software and periodically provide new versions of the software.

Our decision to pay maintenance rests on four tests:

- Do we have a continuing internal commitment to use this software?
- Is the software vendor continuing to improve the product?
- Is the vendor useful in solving problems with the software?
- If the software fails, what's the worst case scenario?

The City and County both have substantial investments in the use of Spillman software. Motorola Solutions provides regular updates to the software and supports our day to day operation of the software.

This software is critical to daily work of police, fire, and 911 dispatchers. Based on these factors, I strongly recommend continued funding of Spillman maintenance.
