

**AN ORDINANCE fixing the salaries of
all members of the Division of Public Safety
of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana
for the year 2026.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana have, according to the powers outlined in IC 36-8-3-3-(d), assigned to all members of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Fort Wayne a job classification under the City Classification System, which classifications should accurately reflect the duties, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Fort Wayne has recommended a maximum salary level for each job category in a systematic way, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council must assure that salaries reflect the duties and responsibilities assigned to each employee, and to be certain that such salaries are fair and equitable, and

WHEREAS, the funds of such salaries are to be provided by the 2026 City Budget operating funds and other sources as may be specified by the Common Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That all members of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Fort Wayne, shall be classified by division/department, job classification and titles herein designated, and that no changes be made in any job classification without the specific approval of the Common Council except for those brought about by collective bargaining with authorized representatives of City employees in accordance with the existing collective bargaining agreements.

SECTION 2. That the following grid of salaries is fixed and authorized as the grid for approved job classifications. Consistent with our compensation philosophy, it is the City's objective that no employee shall be paid below their job classification and the maximum should not be exceeded, except for approved shift differentials, approved longevity pay, approved overtime pay, approved technical skill pay, approved educational bonus, and approved clothing

allowance, as outlined in the City's approved work rules.

The grid, as reflected on Exhibit "A" is an attempt to maintain an orderly, consistent and competitive pay policy that includes a "Grid System" that represents the actual market range for the Non-Union positions within City Government. Any general increase to the Grid shall only occur should the actual market range for a Job Classification increase.

A. That all Fire Command shall be eligible, as determined by the Fire Chief, for any additional benefits afforded the International Association of Fire Fighters. That all Fire Command shall receive the same percentage pay increases as afforded the International Association of Fire Fighters.

B. That all Police Command shall be eligible, as determined by the Police Chief to any additional benefits afforded the Fraternal Order of Police. That all Police Command, Captains and above, shall receive the same percentage pay increases as afforded the Fraternal Order of Police.

SECTION 3. The following is a true and complete listing of all members of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Fort Wayne non-bargaining unit positions by division/department, job classification, and titles. It does not include those positions which are specified as part of a bargaining unit having a written economic agreement with the City negotiated by the City Attorney and approved by Common Council.

SECTION 4. In addition to the compensation for positions listed herein, the City shall contribute 3% of employees' salary to the Indiana Public Retirement System (INPRS) except for those positions which are commonly referred to as Police and Fire Command.

SECTION 5. From and after the first day of January,

1 2026, all members of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Fort
2 Wayne will be paid according to this, the above and following provisions of this
3 ordinance, subject to budgetary limitations, future
4 changes or amendments enacted by Common Council.

5 **SECTION 6.** That civilian employees in the Police and
6 Fire Departments subject to this Ordinance will conform to the Official City Human
7 Resources Policies and Procedures relating to hiring, pay, and other related
8 practices, approved by the Mayor and administered by the City's Human Resources
9 Department.

10 **SECTION 7.** If any section, clause, sentence, paragraph
11 or part, or provisions of this Ordinance be found invalid or void by a court of
12 competent jurisdiction, it shall be conclusively presumed that this ordinance would
13 have passed by the Common Council without such invalid section, clauses,
14 paragraph, part or provisions, and the remaining parts of the Ordinance will remain in
15 effect.

16 **SECTION 8.** The Municipal Code of the City of Fort
17 Wayne references, in codification form, salary ordinances previously adopted by the
18 City Council for past years. Such salary ordinances have a duration of one year and
19 thus, with the exception of the 2025 salary ordinance, have expired. However, to
20 avoid confusion, it is hereby stated that commencing January 1, 2026, any conflict
21 between the terms and conditions hereof and any previous ordinance shall be resolved
22 in favor of this ordinance.

23 **SECTION 9.** Two copies of all attachments and Exhibits
24 referred to in this Ordinance shall be kept on file with the City Clerk of Fort Wayne
25 for the purpose of public inspection.

26 **SECTION 10.** This ordinance shall be in full force and
27 effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
